Job Summary: The primary role of the Restorative Nurse Aide is to provide appropriate aspects of quality patient care and support services under the direct supervision of licensed Therapists. Contribute to the overall positive image of the organization department. Ensures that all required documentation and required forms are appropriately completed included in patient charts.

Essential Duties (include but are not limited to):

- Assists with and performs routine assigned physical and occupational therapy treatments; demonstrating knowledge of treatment goals and precautions in order to assist with or treat patients.
- Provides direct restorative care and delegated therapy tasks.
- Assisting regular CNAs in positioning, ROM ambulation, ADL, cones / splints / contracture care, ADL specifics, safety device application, appropriate padding and wheelchair cushions, and safety device release.

- Maintains safety and cleanliness of work area and equipment.
- Communicates with facility staff.
- Confers with therapists to establish efficient treatment schedules.

- RNA certification is preferred but not required
